Prescription Drug Safety: Know the truth

Over the past three years, teen overdose deaths have doubled.¹ This is, in part, due to an alarming trend of teens consuming fentanyl unknowingly packaged in counterfeit pills that appear as legitimate prescription medication.

Prescription Drug Safety: Know the truth is a newly updated, free digital course that educates students about the potential dangers of misusing prescription medications, including fentanyl. The course – developed in partnership with Truth Initiative, the public health organization behind the nationally recognized **truth**® youth tobacco prevention and education campaign – explores the impact misuse can have on teens' physical and mental health, relationships, communities, and futures. Students uncover what constitutes appropriate use, storage and disposal, as well as misuse and abuse. The tone and design of this updated course is more youth-led and easier to digest by teens with brand new content addressing the dangers of fentanyl and counterfeit drugs.




The Basics

Students identify different types of prescription drugs, how they can affect the body, and some of their harmful side effects.



Science of Addiction

Students explore how substance use disorder can affect the brain and body, knowledge which can ultimately help students avoid developing a problem.



Supporting Others

Students discover how to support others and call for help in situations involving potential prescription drug misuse and overdose.



Fentanyl – Fast and Fatal

Students learn about the basic facts, overdose and poisoning risks, and dangers of illegally made fentanyl and counterfeit pills that contain fentanyl.
